Earlier this month the Government released its latest figures on road crashes, revealing that 1,711 people died on British roads in 2022, a rise of 10% from 2021. A further 28,031 people suffered serious injuries.

TOP TIPS TO STAY SAFE

- Drivers need to remember to carry out vehicle checks before every journey.
- Passengers must remember to always wear a seat belt. Children should be in a correctly fitted child seat.
- Stick to the speed limit!
- Never drive whilst under the influence of drink or drugs.
- Always wear a helmet when cycling. Bikes should be fitted with lights so drivers can see you!
- Children should take part in cycling proficiency training before being allowed to cycle on roads.
- Be aware of the blind spots around trucks and other heavy goods vehicles.
